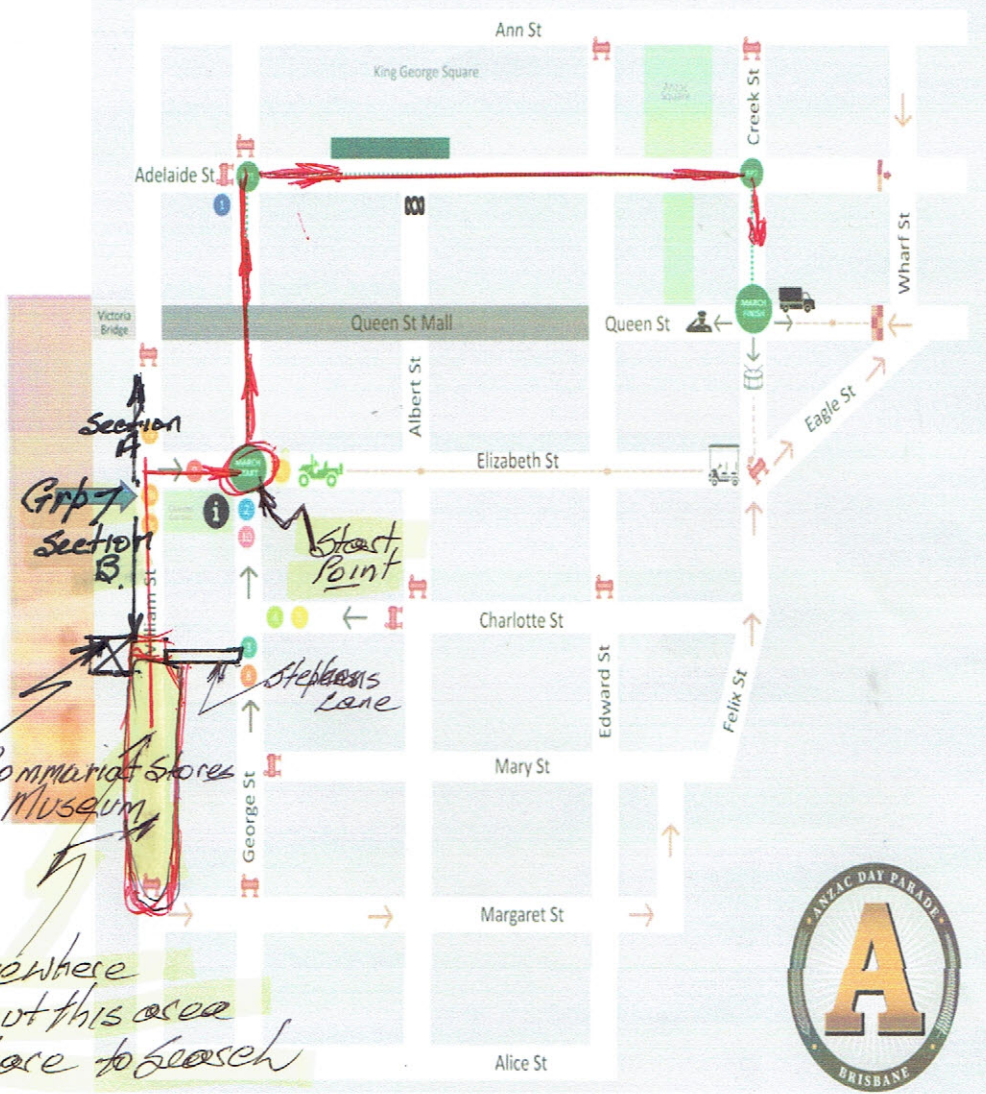

PROTOCOLS

COVID PROTOCOLS

- Be aware of physical distancing requirements when arriving at the Parade and forming up to march
- Make use of sanitisation equipment available alongside toilet facilities
- Do not attend the march if unwell and seek medical attention

MARCH PROTOCOLS

- The wearing of fraudulent medals and awards or displaying decorations not authorised by the Australian Government is NOT permitted:

Section 80B (1), (4) of the Defence Act 1903 makes it an offence for a person to wear a service decoration that they are not entitled to wear, or to falsely represent themselves as a person on whom a service decoration was conferred.

Veterans should wear full size medals

- WWII Veterans able to march the full distance of the Parade are welcome to march behind the WWII Banner in Group 1 accompanied by a carer or person of discretionary age and a wheelchair.
- Those disbanded Units, Ships or Squadrons wishing to parade their

Banner in the Parade may only do so when they have gained

approval from the ANZAC Day Parade Brisbane Committee (ADPB). — OK
