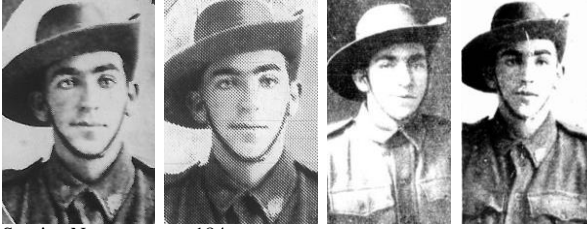

After we had gained our objective on morning of 27th Sep, it was necessary to check our position etc by compass bearing. It was whilst doing this duty that he was hit by a shell and killed instantly. He had only left me a few minutes previously but I could not get definite information for some hours after. The battle was still in progress and enemy attacking made matters difficult. His poor body was afterwards buried on the battlefield close to where he fell, in SE corner of the wood near a place known as Cameron House. The registration of these graves could not be done as the ground was still being fought on, but I can assure you that it will be done as soon as possible. It is difficult to describe details of these affairs, but I hope these meagre lot will assist you in giving information to the enquirer. I wrote to his people in Queensland last October, but I don't think I mentioned about the registration difficulty. Lt Col F W Toll

Killed outright by a shell on the morning of 27th Sep. during our advance at Polygon Wood while in a very advanced position. He was acting as Battalion Intelligence Officer at the time of his death. Was with Lt Thompson, 'A' Coy, I Platoon- " He left me a minute before. I ducked as a shell came and it apparently hit him - about 20yds away- and he was dead when I got to him. Struck in the side. Buried in eastern corner of Polygon Wood, just inside the wood. The grave was not marked then, and I'm sure it hasn't been since. The place has been under heavy shell fire ever since.

This Officer was killed during a reconnaissance in the operations at Polygon Wood on 27th Sep 1917. Buried at Polygon Wood - Parts SE, 1 & 3, 1/50,000 15.b buried between Carlisle Farm and Jerk House.

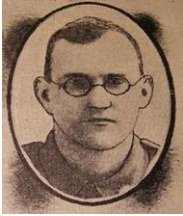

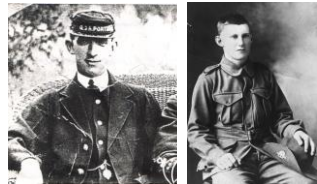

Reported Missing then Wounded and Prisoner of War from 19th/20th Jul 1916, Fromelles.
"We went 'over the top' at 20 minutes to 6 o'clock on the evening of July 19, 1916. We had only come up into the trenches that afternoon from Fleurbaix. It was a big affair, the whole 5th Australian Division taking part in it. Our objective was the enemy trench about 300 yards in front of us. I got out as far as what we believed to be the third line of enemy trenches, but then returned to his second line. There our chaps put in the whole of the night 'digging in' and consolidating our position. We were under a heavy fire and a continuous artillery bombardment during the whole time. Saw the C.O. Colonel FW Toll out in the third line of enemy trenches, also Second in Command, Major Eckersley, also out in the third line of enemy trenches.

During the night I was completely out of action. I received a bullet through the left shoulder and another through the right hand. I lay out through all that night in a shell-hole and was picked up by the Germans early next morning.

I was taken to Douai and I remained in hospital there till October. Then I was sent to the lager at Dulmen, from there the Germans sent me out 'on commando' from a place called Burgsteinfurt. We were put to work among scrap iron and timber. My wound was still running, in fact it is still running. This commando was made up of 40 British Prisoners of War, of whom 10 were Australians. I was in the hospital till 30th Apr 1917 and was then transferred to the lager. I remained in Munster lager till 7th Dec 1917. Then I was moved to Mannheim where I passed the medical board for internment in a neutral country.

I left Mannheim on 26th Dec 1917 and went to the Chateau d'Oex Region in Switzerland. Most of my time there I was in hospital (the 'A.S.A'). The Swiss people were very kind to us, and I received good treatment in hospital. With others I left Switzerland on 11th Jun 1918. We crossed France from the frontier post of Pont Arlier to Le Havre and came across to Southampton in the SS 'Panama', arriving on 14th June. From Southampton we came straight into London and were quartered at the King George Hospital, Waterloo."

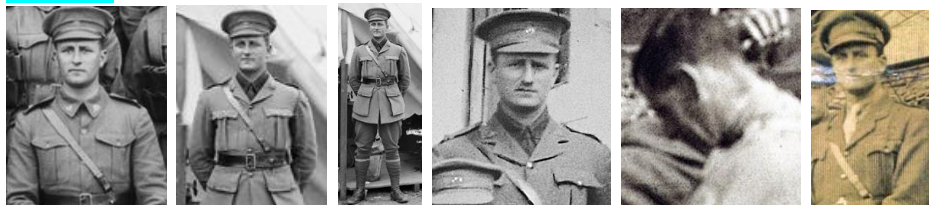

On arriving at the enemy parapet, a German Officer attempted to throw a bomb, but Drayton promptly shot him through the head. He then cut a shoulder strap off the tunic which he handed to the Brigade Major the following*

morning. Captain (then Lieutenant) Drayton afterwards advanced the remnants of his Company to our most forward position in the German lines, and held on all night under a terrific fire. His Company Commander and 2nd in Command were wounded early in the engagement. Since the arrival of his unit on the Somme front, this Officer has shown consistent courage and devotion to duty, and a fine example to the Officers and men of his Company."

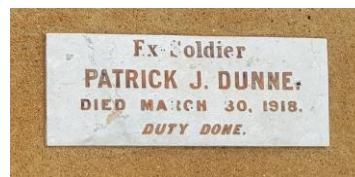
