


Died suddenly on 20th Aug 1918 whilst attached to Australian Infantry Concert Party. Death was due to the late effects of a penetrating wound to the chest, actual cause of the death being haemorrhage into the preicardiem from the breaking down of a wound of the heart wall, failure of the right ventricle and acute pulmonary congestion and oedema. Post mortem examination revealed the fact that "it is clear that the man had at some time ago received a penetrating wound of the chest the bullet having entered the left side of the chest(at the site of the scar)." And in view of the fact that you advise that the Attestation Paper records that on enlistment this man had, as one of distinctive marks, a scar on his left side, it would appear that he has died of injuries received prior to enlistment.
