

On 30th May Sgt Foster with Lieut Knowles were successful in capturing a German runner of 2nd MG Coy, 133rd RIR, 24th Res Div who divulged vital information as to enemy dispositions.

Awarded DCM for actions: "During the attack of the 31st Battalion from WARFUSEE-ABANCOURT on 8th August 1918, this NCO displayed the highest type of bravery and great power of leadership. At one period when his Company was temporarily checked by direct fire at point blank range from a hostile field battery this NCO did splendid work in rallying his men and assisted materially in keeping going the forward movement of the Battalion.

Edwin Foster was born at Rous Mill on 31 January 1897, the son of Frederick E and Constance Foster (nee Snodgrass). He enlisted in Brisbane on 9 July 1915, aged 18. He was a farmer although he had studied to be a teacher, but hadn't finished the course. He left Australia on 9 November 1915 on Wandilla arriving in Egypt just before Christmas. Influenza saw him admitted to 15th Field Ambulance at Tel-el-Kebir on 3 Mar 1916. He served in France with the 31st Battalion from June 1916 and fought in the battles of Fromelles, the Somme and Bapaume where he received a gunshot wound to the left thigh on 16 March 1917 and was admitted to hospital in England. He had been promoted Corporal on 26 July 1917. After recovering he served at Villers-Bretonneux where the battalion captured the large German railway gun. On 4 January 1919 he became a 2nd Lieutenant and on 27 January he was admitted to 8th Australian Field Ambulance with a fractured fibula. He married Winifred Florence White, daughter of George White, in St Paul's Hammersmith Church on 5 July 1919. He returned to Australia on Wahehe on 15 Dec 1919. He received the Distinguished Conduct Medal for his action in France.

For conspicuous gallantry and able leadership when his company was temporarily checked by direct fire from a field battery. He did excellent work in rallying the men and working them forward. After reaching the final objective, he cleared the ground for several hundred yards in advance, inflicting severe casualties on the enemy. His example was eagerly followed by his men.

After his return to Australia he grew bananas at Rocky Creek on the Richmond before joining the Department of Agriculture at Murwillumbah. He joined a unit of the 41st Battalion at Murwillumbah and served from 1939 to 1943. In July 1943 the battalion went to Port Moresby and then Buna. He was discharged in October 1944. He then returned to the Department of Agriculture and was an alderman on Murwillumbah Municipal Council. In 1948 he advised the British Colonial Service on the cultivation of hemp in North

Borneo. He was awarded the MBE for his work there. He retired from the Department in September 1957 and lived at Broken Head Road, Byron Bay where he grew pineapples. His wife died on 28 December 1979 and he died on 19 December 1982. Both are buried at Bangalow.

from the S.W. corner of POLYGON WOOD for a distance of about 400 yards northwards. At 5.30 am after a preliminary Artillery and Machine Gun Barrage of great intensity the enemy advanced to attack the Battalion sector and on the Sector of the British Brigade on our right. Under the strain the Middlesex Regiment holding the line on our right were compelled to give way and fall back for a distance of nearly half a mile. Major Freeman held to his front line with the greatest determination and after repulsing with great loss the enemy in his immediate front, with the aid of a Section of the 15th ALTMB, attached under Lieut GAMBLE, he pushed out his supports in advance of the original line he was holding and endeavoured to counter-attack the enemy; this bold attempt failed in its entirety owing to heavy machine gun fire from the enemy and the failure of the Brigade on our right to adequately support him but he was able to make the enemy withdraw sufficiently to establish a line echeloned to the right of the original flank without withdrawing a foot from his original position. Subsequently when I sent up Reinforcements to him he took an active personal part in directing them into position despite the"

Awarded Bar to DSO for actions: "This Officer was in command of the 31st Battalion in operations to the East of VILLERS BRETONNEUX on the 8th August 1918. His was one of the assaulting Battalions of this Brigade which was detailed for the second phase of the attack. He had the difficult task of pushing his Battalion through Units which took the first objective and forming up East of LA MOTTE-en-SANTERRE. The difficulty of this task was greatly enhanced by the dense fog on the morning of the attack. By his careful preliminary arrangements and personal reconnaissance he brought his Battalion to the 'Jumping Off' line in good time and with very few casualties. During the assault itself he inspired the men to greater efforts, moving about freely in the face of heavy enemy fire issuing instructions and encouraging the troops. When on arrival at the final objective he found that the troops on his right flank had been held up, he formed a defensive flank and gave every assistance possible by supporting fire. During the operation carried out by the Brigade on 9th August, this Officer frequently made reconnaissance's of the front line and sent back very valuable information to Brigade Headquarters. His gallantry and capable leadership throughout was of a very high standard."
