



"Our general advance took place at daylight on 26th September 1917. We had moved up from billets in a rear area, during the night before. We had just reached the line-up tape early in the morning, when we were ordered to advance. It was 10 minutes to 6, when we moved forward. Our objective was an imaginary line about a 1000 yards ahead of us. That was the objective set for 'A' and 'B' Companies. We lost quite a number of men going across. We came to a number of dug-outs and "pill-boxes" and sent back a number of German prisoners.

Officers seen during the engagement.

I saw the following officers during the advance.

<u>Captain McLennan</u>, the OC of 'B' Coy

Lieut Brodie, 'A' Coy he was killed alongside me. It was near a "pill-box" just as we had about reached

our objective.

Wounded and made Prisoner

The men of all battalions were mixed up. A machine gun bullet struck me in the right hand. I made an attempt to get back but was again wounded, this time in the knee. I took cover in a shell hole. This would be about 8 o'clock. I remained there till about 9.30. In the meantime the enemy had counter-attacked and were driving our chaps back. There were eight or 10 of us taken prisoner by the Germans. At the first dressing station behind the lines, my wounds were dressed.

Among those who were taken with me, were the following, all of the 31st Battalion:

Pte 4119 W. Pollock (unwounded)

Pte 4800 A.J. Hother Pte 3812 E.P. Griffiths Pte 3195 S.V/ Nowlan Pte 967 W. Tinham

Hother, I understand is reported "Missing". As we were going back as prisoners, one of our own HE's exploded near the group of us. I did not see Hother afterwards.

What happened immediately after capture.

At a village behind the linesmy smashed fingers were amputated and my wounds dressed. Then we were taken to Courtrai, but went on through Ghent to Cologne in Germany.

I remained at Cologne for two months till 1st December. I was in hospital there. Their treatment was very poor. My wounds were dressed about once a week. Tinham and Nowlan, of the same battalion, were with me at Cologne I was transferred from Cologne to Limburg a/Lahn and remained in the Lager there till 22nd March 1918, when I left for Aachen for exchange.

Across Holland to England

For the time we were at the frontier post of Aachen awaiting exchange, the German treatment was perceptibly improved. Crossing Holland to the port of Rotterdam the Dutch people gave us a very hearty reception all the way along the route. I crossed from Rotterdam on the "SINDORA" and reached Boston on Sunday 14th March 1918. We came straight on to London and have been quartered at The King George Hospital at Waterloo.

I received my first Red Cross parcel on 30th Nov at Cologne and received them regularly afterwards."
